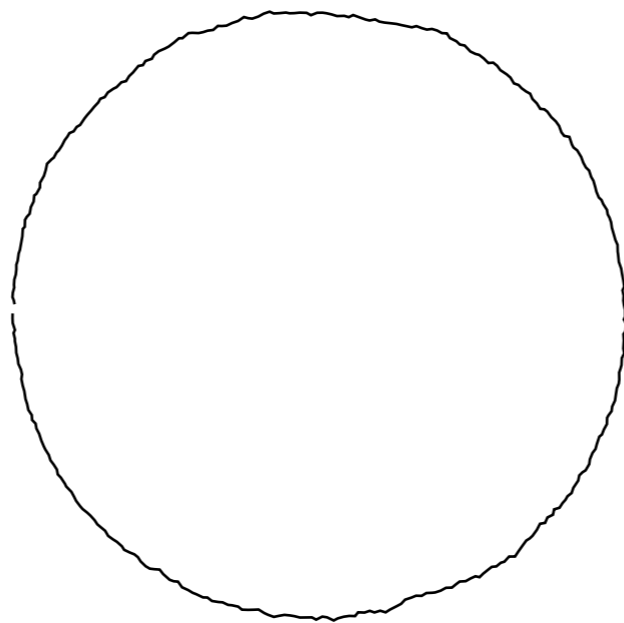

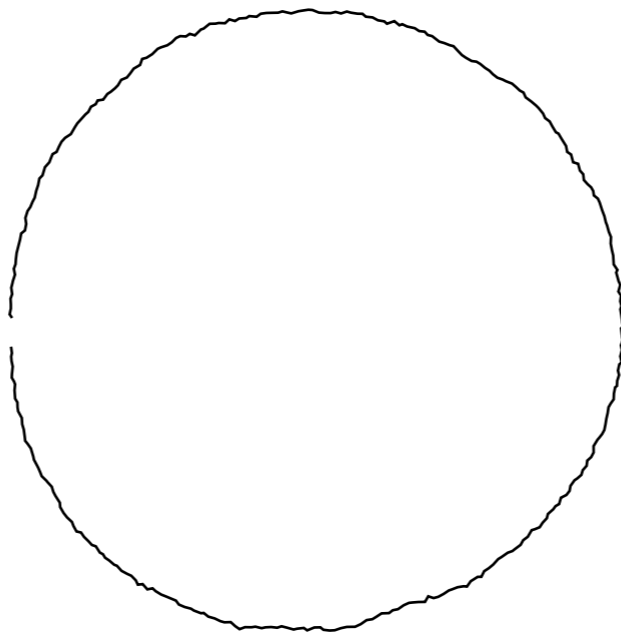


The air conditioner was broken. We were standing outside in

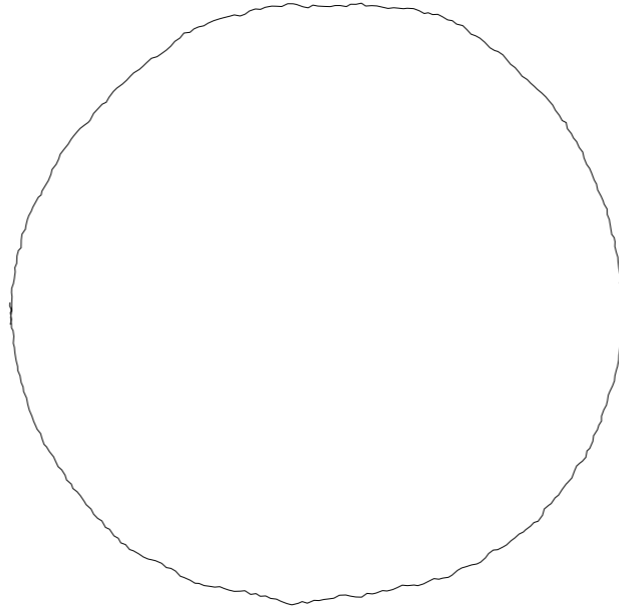


As it fell, the wing hit a plastic float on the runway and the blades broke.

I rose and took the stairs leading up to the Headmaster's Office. I

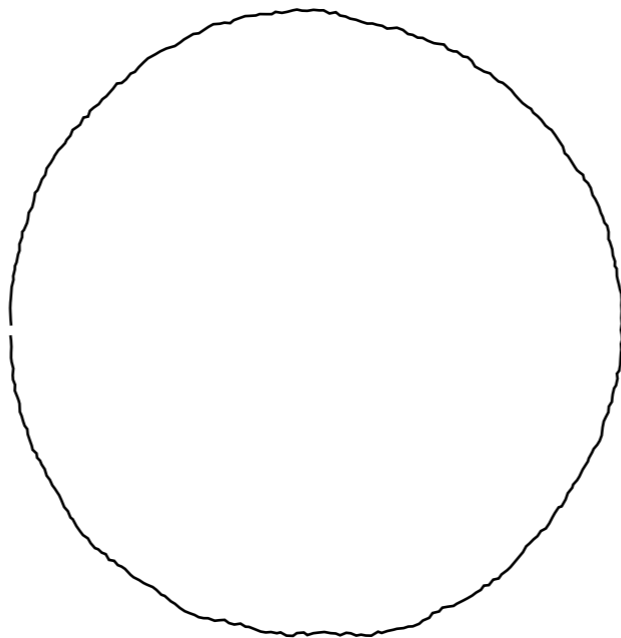
put on my best I.D. as I had done the previous time.

in the castle. And he was fidgety and mumbling things about the Order


of the Phoenix being the real problem. This boy looked about my age.




This is even more true when two people have to get what's called an "arm's length away" from one another. Say they're in the same shop or at the same street corner, and one of them brings some presents for the other.
