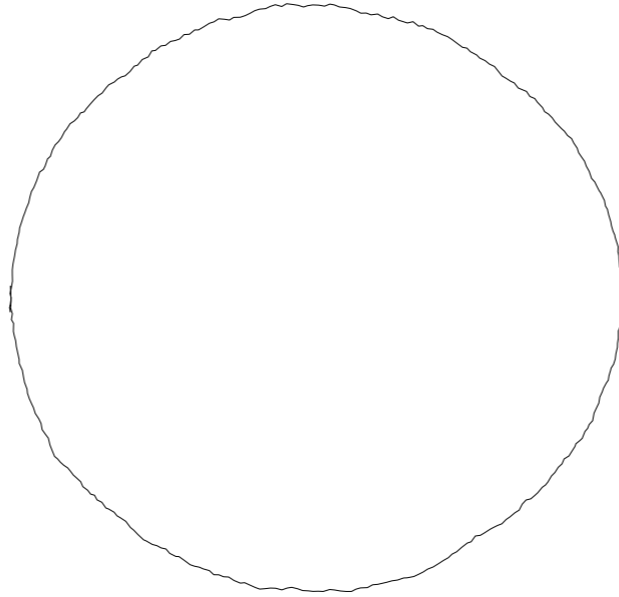

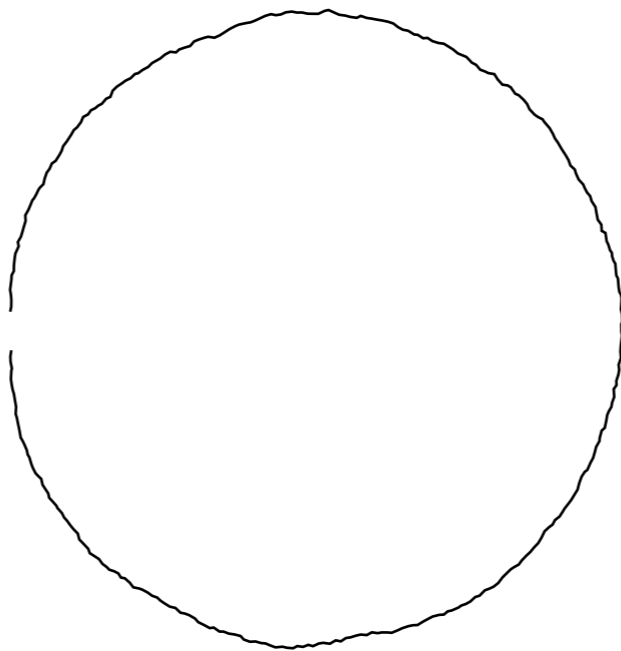

(At least one Tom Waits song was about this.)

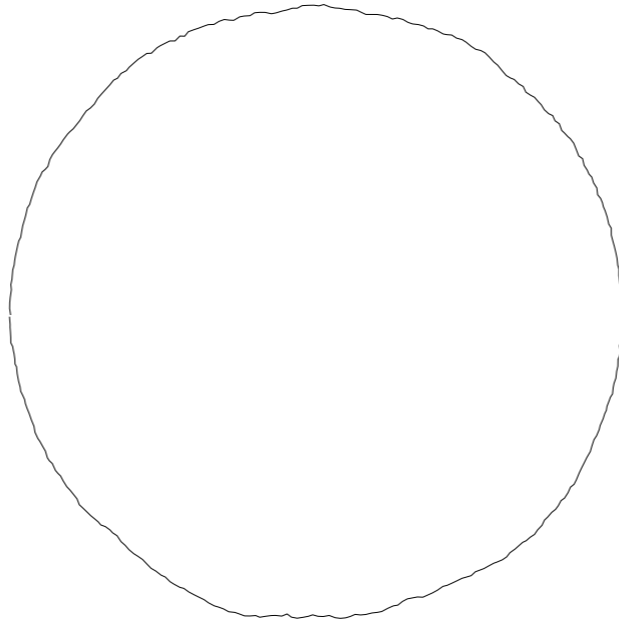
The most important part of this story is the fact that we got

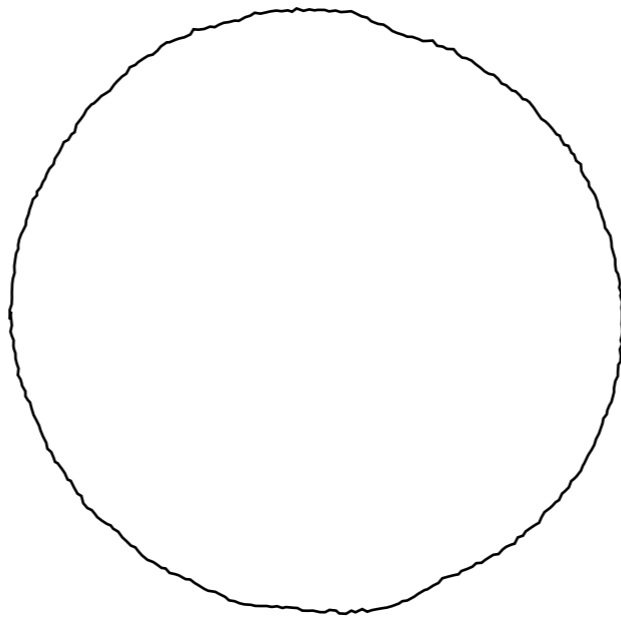

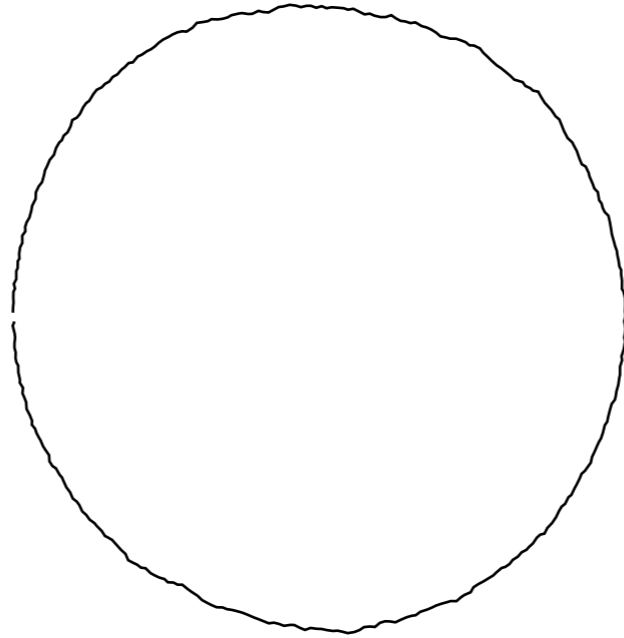
