

Do you sleep with a pillow? What about the blanket?

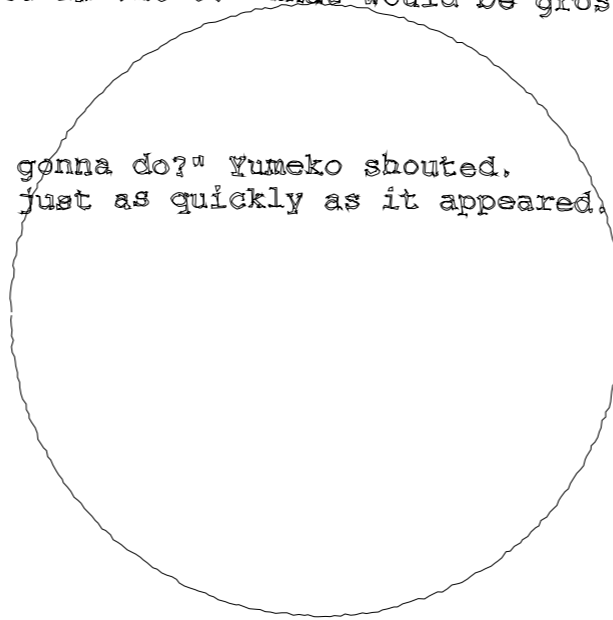
It was all part of a cheerful, cheeky message. Maybe he was just joking.
